Preface

Fast Abstracts are brief two page presentations of a research idea, an opinion, or a project update. They cover a wide variety of issues within the field of software reliability engineering. They are also designed to offer an opportunity for late-breaking results, partial results, or work in progress to be reported in a timely fashion. As such, they are lightly screened by the Fast Abstracts Program Committee and are not subjected to the rigorous referee process for regular ISSRE papers. The late submission deadline and expedited screening, along with the corresponding 5-minute talk during ISSRE, allow for very rapid dissemination and timely feedback from the community.

This year's program features 26 papers (selected from 46 submissions) from university and company scholars and researchers spanning 11 countries. We are particularly pleased to have presentations from scientists and engineers from industry that would not normally have the time to produce a full ISSRE paper. Their contribution mirrors the goal of Fast Abstracts to provide a greater diversity of participation and corresponding exchange of ideas than is possible with regular paper presentations alone.

We hope that this year's presentations stimulate much thought and cross-pollination and make the exchange experience enjoyable.
